Back Gasket

GENERAL:

INSTALLATION:

1. Loosen 4 bolts to remove Lens, Gasket, and Lens Frame to access nuts securing Mounting Bracket. Loosen Stud Brackets to access mounting holes. After attaching the Mounting Bracket to surface, close and tighten the Stud Brackets back over holes and tighten hardware. Remove nuts and retain for later use.

IMPORTANT: Notice Lens Frame orientation for ASYMMETRICAL Models.

Silicone Mounting Plate to surface, wall, or ceiling for IP66 rating, before mounting center over junction box, secure to surface with screws (provided by others 1/4" nominal diameter).






Assembled & Mounted View


